Couples are encouraged to attend a class before their baby is born so that the baptism can be scheduled quickly after the birth. LENTEN REGULATIONS

The Catholic Church calls all Catholics to a deeper spirit of penance, fasting, almsgiving & prayer, "which express conversion in relation to oneself, to God, & to others". To foster a greater spirit of penance, reparation for sin, to encourage self-denial, which guide us more closely in the footsteps of Christ, the Church reminds us of the following obligations of fast & abstinence during Lent, & also admonishes us all to deeper prayer & worship.

Abstinence: All who have celebrated their 14th birthday are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent & Good Friday.

Fasting: Everyone, from the celebration of their 18th birthday to their 59th birthday, is bound

to fast on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. Fasting means eating only one full meal each day. Two other partial meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken; but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.

Voluntary fasting on other weekdays of Lent is highly recommended, as is other forms of fasting.

Almsgiving, the act of giving to the poor, is an expression of penance, a witness of fraternal charity, & an expression of Lenten conversion. Catholics are encouraged to generously support the charitable works of the whole Church: through regular stewardship to their parish & support of charities.

Prayer -- to deepen one's love for Christ, Catholics are urged to participate in the sacramental life of the Church during Lent by attending daily Mass & frequenting the sacrament of Reconciliation.
